

The Spring Mountain Ranch Homeowner's Association seeks to participate with the City of McCall to rebuild Wooley Avenue in McCall between Spring Mountain Boulevard and Davis Street to add a bike/pedestrian path along Wooley Avenue in an effort to help connect existing bike paths/pedestrian corridors along the golf course, from the elementary and middle schools and generally from the east side of McCall to the downtown core.
